

Banner for Confirmation Mass

Basic Instructions

The making of the banner is meant to be a special expression of the Confirmation candidate and their family to mark the celebration of their special day. Be creative and have the banner express the candidate! This banner can be kept for years to come as a keepsake.

It should display the candidate's Confirmation name & family name

- Measurements of banner:
 - Body size 15 x 17 inches
 - Ribbon or cord drop length 3 ½ to 4 ½ inches
- Materials needed:
 - The body of the banner can be still felt, or stiff material such as burlap, etc.
 - Felt pieces to cut out your chapes/designs
 - Glue made to be used on fabric and felt
 - Fabric scissors
 - Any additional trip you might like to use
 - Small diameter dowel cut to size
 - Yarn, ribbon or cord to attach the dowel in order to hang the banner
 - Possibly sewing materials depending on your design

You can purchase the felt at a craft store (Michael's, Hobby Lobby, JoAnn's) or online – type in Confirmation Banner into a Google search. Remember to represent both sacraments in your banner design. See below for examples.

Please bring your completed banner to the Confirmation Mass Rehearsal, the Thursday before the mass. They will be displayed at the end of each pew all around the church during mass.
